Holy Land Classic 2010

Day 1 and 2 - USA to the Holy Land

Your spiritual pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA on an overnight flight. You will be welcomed to the Holy Land by our airport representative and transferred to your hotel. Enjoy dinner before you rest.

Day 3 - The Galilee With Bible in hand, **cross the waters of the Sea of Galilee** aboard a Kinnereth Sailing Company boat. Along the way, participate in a special on board worship service. Travel to **Capernaum**, the center of Jesus' ministry in the Galilee. Visit the **synagogue** which stands on the site where Jesus taught. Recall his teaching and preaching the gospel of the kingdom (Matt.4:13, 23). At Kibbutz Nof Ginnosar, you'll learn about the "**Ancient Boat**", a rare example of the kind of boat in which Jesus would have sailed. Travel to the **Mount of Beatitudes** where Jesus preached to the people (Matt. 5-7). At **Tabgha**, the traditional location for the calling of the disciples and the feeding of the 5000, you'll visit the **Church of the Fish and the Loaves** (Luke 9:10-17). You'll also visit the **Chapel of the Primacy** where three times Peter professed his devotion to the risen Christ (John 21). At the **River Jordan** you can remember your baptism in the Yardenit Baptismal Site.

Day 4 - Beit Shean, Nazareth, Megiddo and Caesarea Visit the ruins of **Beit Shean** which was continuously inhabited for 5000 years and was one of the Roman cities Jesus passed on his way from Galilee to Jerusalem. Visit **Nazareth**, Jesus' boyhood home (Matthew 2: 23). Travel the ancient caravan route to **Tel Megiddo** where 20 different cities lie superimposed upon each other. Visit the Roman Aqueduct and Theatre at **Caesarea**, a center of the early Christians. Here, Cornelius became the first Gentile convert to the new religion (Acts 10) and Paul was imprisoned before being taken to Rome for Trial.

Day 5 - Jericho, Qumran, and Bethlehem

Travel to **Jericho** and visit the ruins of the ancient city, which was conquered by Joshua (Josh. 6: 1, 2, 20). From Jericho, you can see the traditional **site of the Temptation of Jesus** (Matt. 4: 1-11). Even today, the road from Jericho to Jerusalem twists for miles as it climbs from below sea level into the Judean mountains. Jesus traveled the nearby Roman road, the setting of His parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10: 30-36). Travel to **Qumran**, site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery, to discuss the mysterious community of Essenes who once lived on the shores of the Dead Sea. In **Bethlehem**, you'll visit the cave revered as the place where Jesus was born (Matt. 1: 18 - 25; Luke 2: 1- 7). The church, which was constructed on the site, is the world's oldest functioning church. Nearby you'll view **Shepherds' Field** where the Good News was first heard.

Day 6 - Jerusalem Visit the **Haas Promenade** and enjoy a panoramic view from the south of Jerusalem, the Old City walls and the hill called **Mount Moriah** where Abraham was commanded by God to offer Isaac as a burnt offering (Gen. 22: 2, 4). View the **Kidron Valley** and the **Valley of Gehenna**. Stand atop the **Mount of Olives** as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem, including the **Temple Mount** and **Dome of the Rock**. Forty days after his resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the **Mount of Olives** (Acts 1: 9 - 12). Pray in the **Garden of Gethsemane** as Jesus prayed (Matt. 26: 36 - 44). Continue to **Mount Zion** to visit the **House of the High Priest Caiaphas** where Jesus was imprisoned for a night (Matt. 26: 57 - 65). Stand in the **Upper Room**, revered as the place of the Last Supper (Mark 14: 12 - 26). View the site of **King David's Tomb**.

Day 7 - Jerusalem and the Old City

Visit the **Southern Wall Excavations** of the ancient Temple, including the **Teaching Steps** and the **Western Wall**. Walk the **Cardo**, the ancient main street of the Old City. Once lined with shops it is now partially restored. View the **Pool of Bethesda** (John 5: 1-31) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle, and sing a hymn in the **Church of St. Anne**. Visit **Herod's Antonia Fortress** where Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23: 1-11). Walk the **Via Dolorosa**, "the Way of the Cross," and stand in reverence at the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**.

Day 8 - Leisure Day with Optional Masada and Dead Sea Tour

Explore on-your-own or visit **Masada** (additional charge), Herod's mountain-top fortress which became the last stronghold of the Jewish Rebellion against the Romans. Ride the cable car to the top to explore. Peer down upon the remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp below. Time permitting, you'll stop briefly at the Shores of the **Dead Sea** for a quick dip in the salt and mineral laden waters.

Day 9 - Jerusalem

Travel to **Ein Karem**, known as the birthplace of John the Baptist and the place where the Virgin Mary visited Elisabeth (Luke 1: 26-40). Time permitting, you will visit **Yad Vashem**. Visit and worship at the **Garden Tomb**, possible site of the garden of Joseph of Arimathea and experience the reality of the Resurrection. Your afternoon is free for exploring.

Day 10 - Extension or Return

Depart on an exciting extension or return to USA.

Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this brochure. While you will see all sites listed above, the order of sites and/or days and number of days may be altered to accommodate changes in airline, hotel schedules, and local conditions. Due to airline schedules, some participants may receive one or two extra leisure days at a nominal per day charge and some extensions may not be available on all departure dates. Minimum of 50 passengers required to operate the lecture program; a minimum of 15 passengers required to operate an optional or most extensions.

Cairo and the Route of the Exodus

7-day* extension \$898

Day 10 Early morning departure from Jerusalem. Cross the Sinai, traveling ancient caravan routes across the Sinai to the base of **Mt. Sinai** for overnight.

Day 11 Visit the **Monastery of Saint Catherine** at the base of **Mount Sinai**. Trace the route of the Exodus along the eastern Sinai coast to **Wadi Feiran** where the Children of Israel withstood the Amalekites. Travel to **Elim** where the Children of Israel camped by the oasis of 70 palm trees. Your final stop of the day will be **Marah** by the **Red Sea** where the "waters were bitter." Continue to **Cairo** for dinner and a four night stay.

Day 12 Travel as Abraham did to **Memphis** (Biblical Noph) and on to **Sakkara** where you will see the **Step Pyramid**, the world's oldest stone structure. See the **Great Pyramids of Giza** and the **Sphinx**.

Day 13 Travel south to view **Joseph's River and Lake**, created by Joseph during the period of the seven years of famine. Visit a **grain silo** of the kind established under Joseph's rule to store grain during the seven years of famine. Tour the rural region of traditional Egyptian farming and stop at an **old corn water mill**.

Day 14 Admire the ancient treasures of the **Egyptian Museum**.

Day 15 Continue to the Sinai for overnight.

Day 16 and 17 Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.

Wonders of Egypt and Luxor

7-day* extension \$1298

Day 10 - 11 Your Itinerary is the same as the Cairo and the Route of the Exodus (see above).

Day 12 Travel as Abraham did to **Memphis** (Biblical Noph) and on to **Sakkara** where you will see the **Step Pyramid**, the world's oldest stone structure. See the **Great Pyramids of Giza** and the **Sphinx**. In the early evening, board the overnight train to Luxor.

Day 13 & 14 (Lunches included on these days.) Cross the Nile River to visit the **Valley of Kings and Queens**. After overnight in Luxor, visit the magnificent **Karnak Temple** and the **Luxor Temple**. **Fly to Cairo**.

Day 15 Admire the ancient treasures of the **Egyptian Museum**. Continue to the Sinai for overnight.

Day 16 and 17 Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.

***Note: The Cairo Route of the Exodus Extension and the Egypt Luxor Extension will operate together on Days 10-12**

Nile Cruise

7-day* extension \$1398

Day 10 -11 Your itinerary is the same as the Cairo and the Route of the Exodus (see above).

Day 12 This morning you will enjoy a half day tour of **Cairo**, including the **Egyptian Museum**, the **Great Pyramids of Giza** and the **Sphinx**. This afternoon you will fly to Aswan where you will board your Nile Cruise boat.

Day 13 Visit the **High Dam of Aswan** and the **Granite Quarry** where you can see the **Unfinished Obelisk**. Visit the **Temple of Philae** before sailing to the beautiful **Temple of Kom Ombo**. After your visit to the temple shared by two gods, your cruise continues along the **Nile**.

Day 14 Visit the **Temple of Horus** in **Edfu**. Continue via the **Nile Lock** and sail to **Luxor**.

Day 15 Disembark and cross to the Western Bank where you will visit the **Necropolis of Thebes**, the **Valley of the Kings and Queens**, the **Temple of Hatshepsut** and the **Colossi of Memnon**. On the East Bank, you'll visit the amazing **Temples of Luxor and Karnak**. Fly back to **Cairo** for dinner and overnight.

Day 16 and 17 Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.

Wonders of Jordan and Petra

7-day extension \$1098

Day 10 This morning depart Israel via the **Allenby Bridge**, drive to **Jerash**, the Greco Roman city, (known as Pompeii of the middle East) visit the **Roman Theatre**, the **Forum**, **Street of Columns**, **Hadrian Arch**, **Temple of Artemis**, **Jabbok River**, where Jacob wrestled with the Angels of the Lord. Overnight in Amman.

Day 11 Travel to **Petra**, one of the new wonders of the world. Visit the many **Nabatean tombs, temples and palaces**. Overnight at this spectacular site.

Day 12 Depart **Petra** to **Wadi Rum**, known as valley of the moon, and where Lawrence of Arabia lived. Enjoy a Jeep ride, return to Petra for dinner and overnight.

Day 13 Travel to **Aqaba**, known for its marine life, and the castle of Lawrence of Arabia. Return to Petra, for overnight.

Day 14 Travel to **Kerak**, and visit the **Crusader Castle**, and the **Cave of Lot**. Overnight at the Dead Sea.

Day 15 Visit of **Madaba**, the home town of Ruth, the Moabite, and **Mt. Nebo**, where Moses viewed the Holy Land. Overnight at the Dead Sea.

Day 16: Transfer to Allenby Bridge for re-crossing to Israel and your return flight to the USA.
