

Master of Arts in Pastoral Counseling – Master of Social Work

The Master of Arts in Pastoral Counseling/Master of Social Work (MAPC/MSW) is a 94 credit hour program in which students can earn a Master of Arts in Pastoral Counseling from Moravian Theological Seminary and a Master of Social Work from Marywood University School of Social Work. The curriculum consists of the core courses of both the MAPC and MSW programs, while electives and field work are consolidated. Full-time students can complete the dual degrees in three years rather than the four years necessary to pursue the degrees if taken separately.* To enroll in the dual degree program students must apply to, and be accepted by, both Moravian Theological Seminary and Marywood University School of Social Work.

The MAPC–MSW program is ideal for students who seek to integrate a spiritual and theological understanding into their practice of counseling AND look to hold an administrative position in a counseling/mental health setting.

In the MAPC/MSW program, students will take
 46 credit hours in MAPC at Moravian Theological Seminary
 48 credit hours in MSW at Marywood University
 94 credit hours total

 60 MSW credits + 62 MAPC credits = 122 credits
