

MAPC EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Educational requirements for licensure (in *italics*, as found in Pennsylvania Act 49.2 governing LPC licensure), and the Moravian courses that currently meet them, are as follows:

Human Growth and Development—(2 semester hours) studies that provide an understanding of the nature and needs of individuals at all developmental stages.

SEPF 936 Human and Faith Development 3 credit hours

Social and Cultural Foundations – (2 semester hours) studies that provide an understanding of issues and trends in a multicultural and diverse society.

SEPF 917/SEBO 954 Developing Effective Cultural Competency Skills 3 credit hours

Helping Relationships –(2 semester hours) studies that provide an understanding of counseling and consultation processes.

SEPF 733 Pastoral Care and Counseling 3 credit hours

SEPF 773 Individual Psychotherapy and Methodology 3 credit hours

Group Work – (2 semester hours) studies that provide an understanding of group development, dynamics, counseling theories, group counseling methods and skills and other group approaches.

SEPF 776 Group Theory and Practice 3 credit hours

Career and Lifestyle Development – (2 semester hours) studies that provide an understanding of career development and related life factors.

SEPF 972 Career Assessment and Vocational Counseling 3 credit hours

Appraisal – (2 semester hours) studies that provide an understanding of individual and group approaches to assessment and evaluation.

SEPF 772 Clinical Assessment and Treatment Planning 3 credit hours

SEPF 972 Career Assessment and Vocational Counseling 3 credit hours

Research and Program Evaluation – (2 semester hours) studies that provide an understanding of types of research methods, basic statistics, and ethical and legal considerations in research.

SEPF 909 Research Design and Methodology 3 credit hours

Professional Orientation – (2 semester hours) studies that provide an understanding of all aspects of professional functioning including history, roles, organizational structures, ethics, standards and credentialing.

SEPF 976 Professional Ethics and Counseling Practices 3 credit hours

Clinical Instruction – (includes 100 clock hours of supervised practicum experience and 600 clock hours of supervised internship experience). The supervised internship experience shall begin after completion of the supervised practicum experience.
